

Another way is to purchase cursors and other facility upgrades like any other upgrade on the right side of the screen. Cursors are relatively cheap, so it's easy to upgrade your milk percentage by buying them. You also get achievements for purchasing certain upgrades, such as 200 upgrades, where you can increase your CpS. You also have different flavors of milk that do not affect gameplay but are just cosmetic, and some upgrades like Kitten Wages make kitten upgrades 10 percent cheaper. Lastly, there are many strategies to gain a lot of CpS and become a cookie clicker monster baker, including using various building and aura upgrades. Always keep in mind the current formula for calculating milk which is based on achievements divided by 25, giving you 4% milk per achievement. I have achieved 40 accomplishments, which has yielded me 160% milk, as anticipated. However, I recently discovered that not all achievements are valid. The August 27th update revealed that due to public demand, five retired achievements (the "reset your game" and "chase" ones) were removed from the statistics. Although they can still be unlocked, they no longer count toward the total achievement percentage.
